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2009-10 NP Sample Survey

- Sample stratified by population foci, slight oversampling of smallest categories
- Online survey
 - 7-paged, 76-item survey with cover letter
- Replicated 1989, 1999, 2004 surveys, with some modifications and additions to account for evolving practice

Typical NP

- Female, 48 years old
- Family NP (FNP)
- Graduate education
- ~11 years experience as RN prior to NP
- Practices in ambulatory, primary care
- Extremely satisfied in current position
- No current plans to retire

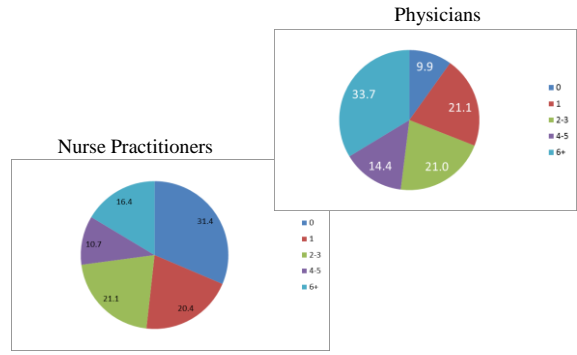

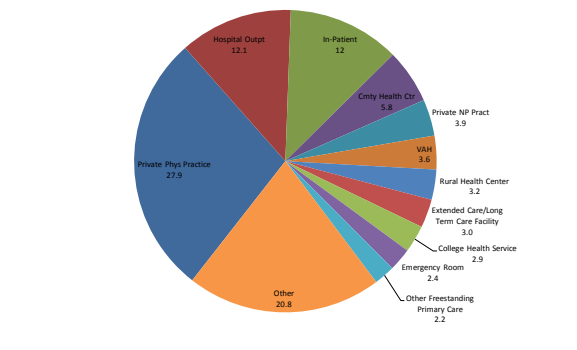
Number of Other Providers in Setting

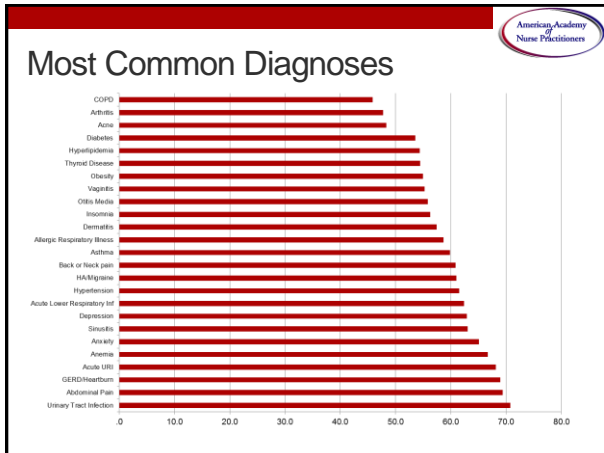

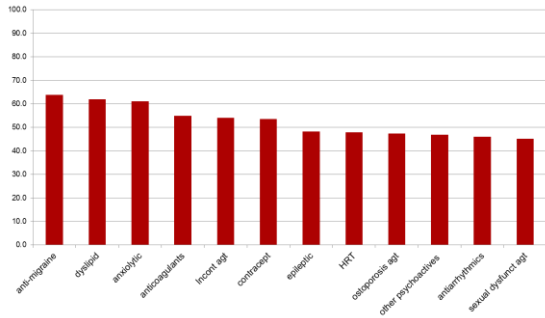

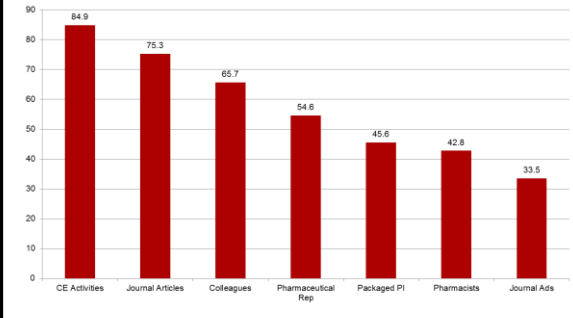
- ### NP Prescribing
- 2004:
 - 96.5% of NPs prescribe
 - 19 prescriptions, on average, daily
 - 2009:
 - 97.6% prescribe
 - 19.7 prescriptions, on average, daily
 - 76.8% maintain DEA registration
 - 78.1% authorized to prescribe controlled substances



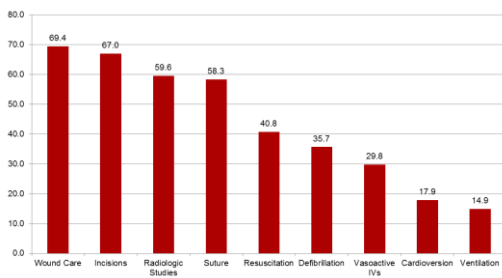
Regularly Prescribed



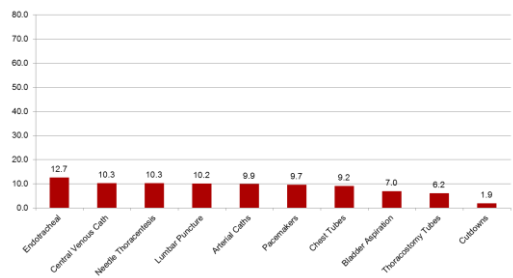
Where information regarding new drugs obtained



Acute Care Procedures Most Frequently Performed



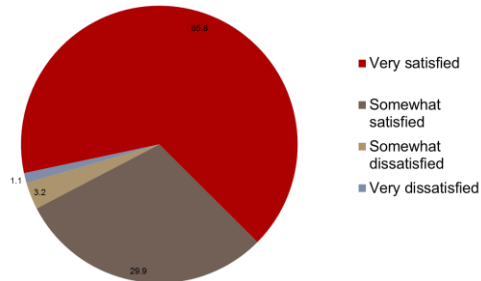

Trends: Continuation of Current Directions:

- Growth of FNP focus
- Exponential growth in NP numbers (next 5 years)
- Gradual increase in NP retirements
- NPs (like physicians) less likely to practice in private practice sites and more likely to practice in hospital-owned practices (ACO influence)
- Continued service to rural and other underserved populations
- Increased public awareness of NPs, driving enhanced employment and compensation opportunities
- Influence of doctoral degree prevalence
