Overview

Social media is revolutionizing the way that people access health information, find supportive services, and interact with primary care providers. There are currently more than 800 million active users of Facebook; more than 200 U.S. hospitals have Facebook, YouTube channels, and Twitter accounts, and every second one hour of video is uploaded to YouTube. More than half of adults have used the Internet to look up health information. How do nurse practitioners practice in a world where the internet serves as a source of health information? How do we prepare NP students to practice in a world where Facebook and YouTube are communities larger than the population of North America?
